Catholics are urged to contact their MPs today to stop the legalisation of Assisted Suicide.

On Wednesday 16th October, the House of Commons will hear the first reading of a new bill on assisted suicide tabled by Labour MP Kim Leadbeater; the timing of the bill makes it probable that MPs will have a vote on assisted suicide before Christmas this year. The Catholic Church teaches that life is a gift to be cherished and cared for from conception until natural death. While the bill may have the support of well-known figures, it is not supported by the Church's teaching which is consistent with regard to the dignity of life.

First Holy Communion Catechists

The preparation sessions are centred around the parents teaching their children, using support material provided, and with input and guidance from catechists. We have a good team of catechists, but we need a couple more people to help with things like setting up, welcoming, clearing away and, most importantly, helping with refreshments.

There are six sessions, Saturdays 10am — 12:15pm, once a month, starting in November. **Could you offer your time?** The only qualifications are the ability to smile and be friendly, make tea, coffee and squash, (all necessary ingredients provided), and to not be fazed by children (and sometimes their parents!) making a lot of noise.



Children's Liturgy Group Leaders

Our children's liturgy group takes place during the 9am Mass at St Theresa's (in the side chapel), during term time. We need a few more adult volunteers to lead the sessions please. We generally have around six to ten children each week, between the ages of about 4 and 8 years old. If you would like to get involved please speak to Juliette or Charlotte.

What is Children's Liturgy?

It is the Liturgy of the Word suitably adapted to make it relevant to the lives and experiences of young children. It gives them the opportunity to understand the Gospel message and participate in the Eucharistic celebration at their own level. We invite children in school years Reception to Year 3 to join the group.

Who will lead the Liturgy of the Word for Children?

We have a few group leaders for this ministry, including teachers and parents from St Mary's School, but we do need more!

All group leaders must have an enhanced DBS check and safeguarding training, both are provided by the parish. There will always be two group leaders at each session.
