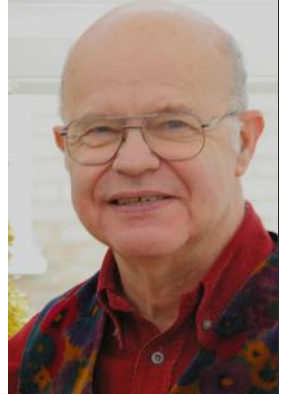

## St Vincent de Paul Society



The SVP take a person-to-person approach to supporting people not just in our parish but the wider community. We extend the hand of friendship to the lonely and isolated by visiting them regularly and taking them out

occasionally. The SVP run a furniture scheme to help those who have been homeless, now have a place to live, but no furniture. This scheme is also used to support families who are struggling to buy furniture. For families we visit, who are finding it hard to make ends meet, we can help by referring them to the foodbank. Through the SVP "Small Project" scheme we have been able to buy milking buffalos for three families in India. Recently we supported the Grenada disaster appeal by using the money we had raised from the Cash4Coins scheme. We work as a team and support each other. All visits are done in pairs. If anyone is interested and would like to learn more about the SVP, they are welcome to come to our next meeting which will be in the meeting room at the back of St Theresa's, on **Thursday 26th September at 6pm.**

## Cash4Coins

We can accept any old coins or bank notes from the UK or around the world, whether current currency or not. With parishioners returning from their summer holiday they may well have unused currency they wish to donate, again either notes or coins can be accepted. There is a jar at the back of both churches where donations can be placed. Working with Cash4Coins, a currency service for charities, all the above can be converted into UK legal tender for the benefit of the SVP both locally and to support the wider work of the
