Fr Tony Writes

This week I will be away a bit. From Sunday evening to Tuesday I will be at Worth Abbey. I go every so often for a day or two of recollection, in which I spend time in prayer and reflection. This, of course, includes praying for you all in the parish.

Then on Wednesday and Thursday I will be joining all the priests of the diocese for our annual In Service Training. We will be learning more about the new Lectionary.

The Lectionary is the book which sets out the readings for Mass. In fact there are three volumes at present, and the new version will be in four volumes. In the new version we will have the readings for the many feasts that



have been added to the calendar since the old one was published around 50 years ago.

The new lectionary will also use a different translation of the Bible: the *English Standard Version, Catholic Edition* (ESVCE), replacing the Jerusalem Bible, which is the translation we currently use. I will say more about the change of translation in the coming weeks, but this will provide us with an opportunity to renew our appreciation of the Word of God proclaimed in the liturgy.

The new Lectionary comes into force in Advent this year, and in the autumn we will be offering opportunities to learn more about it and the place of scripture in the liturgy.

The books themselves are both strongly and beautifully bound, designed to last decades and be worthy of the liturgy. Because of that they are also quite expensive! And we need to get two sets! If anyone would be interested in sponsoring a volume, please contact Fr Tony for more details.

Fr Celestine will celebrate the Wednesday evening Mass this week, and there will be no Thursday morning Mass at St George's.
